SEEKING SOLUTIONS

DANCING WITH THE TRINITY

Look at the stained glass windows in the Church. They dance the Nicene Creed for us in light. The Nicene Creed reveals the dancing of the Holy Trinity, and we are partners in their dance.

St Patrick loved the Holy and life-creating Trinity. His poem/prayer called the Lorica reveals the sacred dance of the holy quite well. He tells us that all of creation: Sun, Moon, Rain, Thunders, etc. share the creative energies of God with us.

Stand up and do a Trinity dance today:

- 1. With hands held high greet the Father
2. With hands outstretched as if in the Cross, greet Jesus
3. Bending at the waist greet the Holy Spirit

And/or

Pray this Psalm:

'Come let us bow down in worship, (bow low) Let us kneel before the one who made us; (kneel down) For he is our God, (stand with hands held aloft) And we are the people he shepherds.' (open your arms to enfold the flock)

National headache month has found its way to JUNE. Headaches may seem like a very minor health problem, but they account for 10 million physician visits per year and are the most common reason why people are absent from work or school. If you have frequent headaches, see your physician to rule out a serious problem. It is estimated that 90% of all headaches are tension headaches typically with a dull, steady pain on both sides of the head. Basically, they are caused by muscle tension brought on by emotional or physical stress.

Prevention suggestions include:

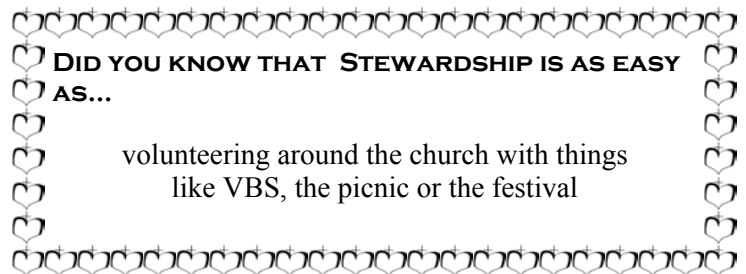
- \* Ease stress \* Get enough sleep
