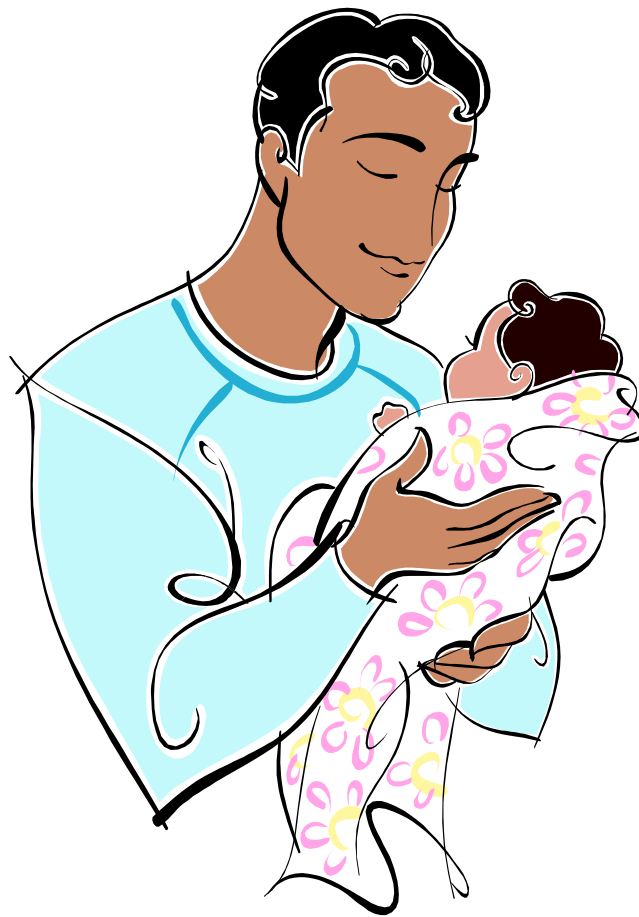

St. Luke Society symposium on July 12 features Dr. Thomas W. Hilgers

The St. Luke Society of the Diocese of Greensburg will host Dr. Thomas W. Hilgers as the keynote lecturer at a symposium Sunday, July 12, from 6-9 p.m. at the Bishop William G. Connare Center near Greensburg. Dr. Hilgers is the founder and director of the Pope Paul VI Institute for the Study of Human Reproduction and an international expert on reproductive technologies and theories that are morally acceptable because they respect life and are directed by the teachings of Catholic Church. The program for the symposium, "Procreation and Reproductive Technologies within the Teachings of the Roman Catholic Church," will include remarks by Bishop Lawrence E. Brandt and talks by Dr. Michel Therrien, academic dean and assistant professor of moral theology at Saint Vincent Seminary, and Dr. Ralph A. Capone, internist, president of the St. Luke Society and member of the administrative board of the Pennsylvania Catholic Conference. A panel discussion will follow. 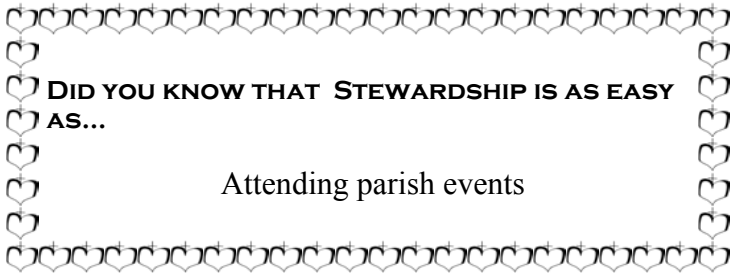
