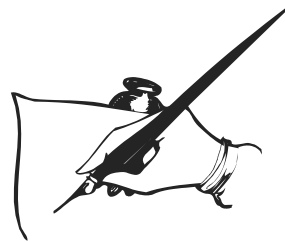

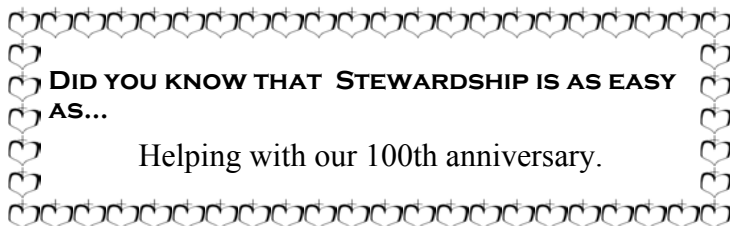

The following is a quote from the St. Florian bulletin on January 6, 1946:

“All adults who didn’t get their 1946 envelopes are to come to the rectory for same. It’s not sportsmanlike to try to get out of doing one’s duty. If you didn’t get envelopes, it was because the Pastor didn’t know of you. Let’s all pull together & we’ll get places.”

As we look ahead to our 100th Anniversary, we see that in some respects, things aren’t so different now as they were over 60 years ago. If we had bulletins from 1910, it wouldn’t surprise me to see the same type of message from the pastor! Let’s all “pull together” as a parish for not only our centennial celebration but in our day-to-day lives.

**EYE SAFETY FOR YOUNG AND OLD**

**DOS AND DON'TS**

- DO use sunglasses with UV protection

- DON'T stare at the computer or computer game for long periods
- DO use protective eyewear in the garage with power tools
- DO wash your hands regularly

- DO avoid flying toys or projectile-firing toys
- DON'T play with toys which have sharp points, spikes, sharp edges
