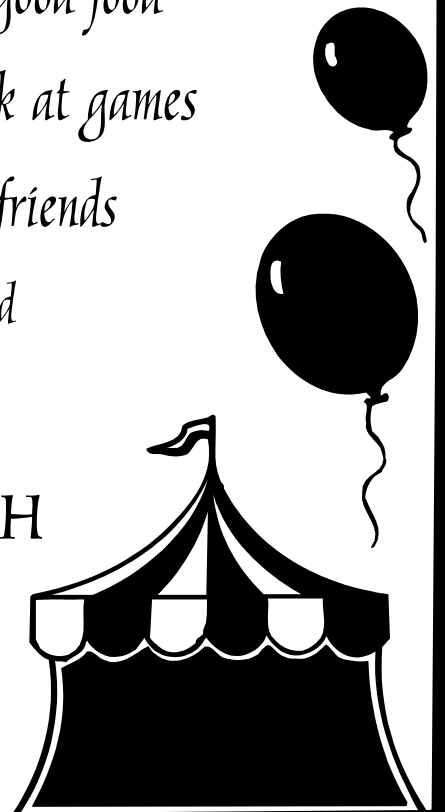



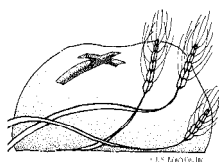

MISSION COOPERATION APPEAL

This weekend a priest from the Amen Foundation will celebrate all Masses. We will take up a collection for the mission work the Foundation does. The Diocese of Greensburg has provided special envelopes and the second collection will be for the Missions only.

DO NOT GIVE MONEY OR CHECKS DIRECTLY TO THE PRIEST OR THE MISSION. If you are giving by check, make it payable to St. Florian, enclose it in the green Mission Cooperation Appeal envelope and drop it into the basket. The parish will submit one check to the Mission Office.

There will be one second collection for the Missions; **drop all monies for the parish into the first collection.**

A Word from the Office of Faith Formation

Last weekend a pastoral letter was read from our Bishop outlining the importance of lifelong faith formation. Some changes brought about in the Catechetical Master Plan and how they will affect St. Florian include:

1. *The establishment of a Training and Catechetical Certification Process for those who hold catechetical roles in our parishes*
 - All Catechetical Leaders (Directors of Faith Formation), catechists, youth ministry leaders/volunteers, RCIA leaders and team members will be required to attend and complete workshops on the four pillars of the Catechism of the Catholic Church: creed, Sacraments, morality, and prayer. There will be an establishment of Basic and Permanent Certification Levels.
2. *Change in the age for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation*
 - The normative age for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation in the Diocese of Greensburg will be about the age of 13 (grade 8) by the 2017 -2018 catechetical year. The transition to this norm will be a gradual one.
 - To bring about this gradual change, the Diocese has been divided into three groups, with St. Florian being part of Group 3. It affects the age for the reception of Confirmation for our children in this way:
 - children entering 2nd grade in 2009-2010 will receive Confirmation when they are in 4th grade
 - children entering 1st grade in 2009-2010 will receive Confirmation when they are in 6th grade
 - children entering Kindergarten in 2009-2010 will receive Confirmation when they are in 8th grade
 - This will take us to the 2017-2018 catechetical year, and from that point onward all confirmations will be about the age of 13 (grade 8).
 - The Bishop will administer the sacrament of Confirmation. The parish priest will continue to administer First Holy Communion during the child's 2nd grade year at parish level.
