Even though we see summer drawing to a close, SAFETY is still open and so are good days for bike riding. Here are just a few reminders about BIKE SAFETY.

- \* Always ride on the RIGHT side of the road
- \* When approaching a busy intersection get off the bike and walk it across the intersection.
- \* The bicycle should be equipped with reflectors, headlights, brakes and a bell or horn.
- \* The best protection for the head is an appropriate bike helmet.
- \* Enjoy the relaxing and beneficial effects of riding a bike.
- Cycling is a good time to just enjoy the surroundings and wheel away all the worries of the day.

SPECIFICS OF THE ESSAY CONTEST:

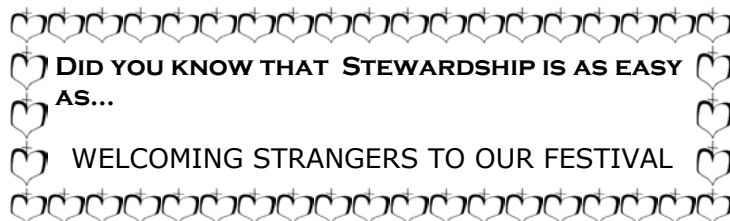
Entries from Grades 3 - 5: 150 words - Poetry or essay acceptable
