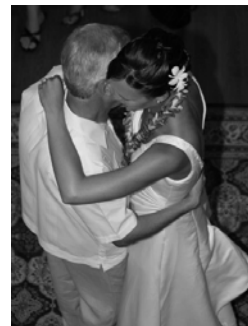

SEEKING SOLUTIONS TOGETHER
LITURGICAL CHANGES

The Sacramentary, which in the future will be referred to as the *Roman Missal*, has been revised to better reflect the original meaning. The revision has been overseen by the International Commission on English in the Liturgy (ICEL).

Scripture readings, hymns, and the Prayer of the Faithful will not be affected. The changes will affect the responses spoken/sung at every Mass and the prayers the priest recites from the Sacramentary (Roman Missal).

The first changes you will notice involve the Introductory Rites. The chart below summarizes some of the changes you will find in the Confiteor:

Current Translation:

I confess to almighty God,
and to you, my brothers and sisters,
that I have **sinned through my own fault**
in my thoughts and in my words,
in what I have done,
and in what I have failed to do;
and I ask blessed Mary,
ever virgin,
all the angels and saints,
and you, my brothers
and sisters, to pray for me to
the Lord, our God.

New Translation:

I confess to almighty God,
and to you, my brothers and sisters,
that I have **greatly sinned** in
my thoughts and in my words,
in what I have done and in
what I have failed to do.
through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I
ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin,
all the Angels and Saints, and
you, my brothers and sisters,
to pray for me to the
Lord our God.

Over the coming weeks and months, we will publish additional changes that will be implemented after the final version is approved by Rome.
